Frosh Burcham again amazing

AAA team titles to Jefferson boys, Buckhannon-Upshur girls

CLASS AAA HIGHLIGHTS

- Another amazing meet for Cabell-Midland fr **Jacob Burcham**, who anchored winning 4x8, was 2nd in 1600 (4:17.06), 4th in 800 (1:57.01) and 2nd in 3200 (9:15.94)
- Youth was also served by Jefferson soph **Brandon Doughty** and frosh **Dante Price**, who led the team champs. Doughty won the 1600 in 4:14.30, had 3rds in the 800 and 3200, and a leg on the runner-up 4x800. Price added 2nds in the 100 and 200, and legs on 2 runner-up relays
- Fairmont sr **Dayton McVicker** won the 3200 in 9:14.23, while St. Albans sr **Andy Bailey** took the 800 in 1:54.03
- Freshman **Emily Godwin** won the HJ and was in on 26 other pts (2nd 300H, SHR win, 4x4 2nd), while jr **Karissa Knabenshue** led a 29 point effort in the throws, leading **Buckhannon-Upshur** to the AAA girls team title
- Hurricane jr **Alex Dent** 5:09.60 1600 / 11:00.56 3200 double, winning close battles with Elkins jr **Letitia Propst** both times. Propst was also 2nd in the 800
- Hurricane jr **Josie Crouch** 57.91 400 / 2:13.75 800 double. Crouch and Dent also both ran on Hurricane's winning 4x800
- Martinsburg sr **Khiry Timbers** was in on 36 pts, with 48.25 400 win, 2nd in 800 1:55.44, legs on winning 4x4, 2nd place 4x8
- Wheeling Park soph **Errin Baynes** 6-10 HJ
- Elkins soph **Cam Viney** 14.43 110H (nwi) / 38.17 300H double
- George Washington sr **Shaquille Williams** won the 100 and had legs in the winning 4x1 and 4x2
- Washington soph **Jasmyn Hosby** 12.23 100 / 25.43 200 (both nwi) double

CLASS AA HIGHLIGHTS

- Frankfort fr **Bria Walker** 57.71 400 / 25.65 200 (nwi) / 16-10.50 LJ (nwi) triple, plus 2nd in 100
- The Oak Hill girls got a 1st and 2nd from **Neaire Miller** in the 800 and 1600, and 2nds in two relays in an 11-pt. team win
- **Ritchie County** won the boys team crown on the strength of wins from **Mark Britton** (171-06 DT, plus 2nd in SP) and **Cody Masters** (13-07 PV), and 22 relay points
- Philip Barbour jr **Sarah McCauley** 5:09.06 1600 / 11:26.67 3200 double
- Liberty soph **Brandon Franklin** tripled the 400 (49.40), 200 (22.19, nwi), and LJ (21-06.25, nwi)
- Berkeley Springs jr **John Munday** doubled the 1600 (4:32.22) and 3200 (9:54.19), and ran on the winning 4x8

CLASS A HIGHLIGHTS

- St. Mary's sr **Kyle Davies** quadrupled the 100 in 11.29, 200 in 23.08 (both nwi), and 400 in 50.71, and LJ in 20-07 (nwi)
- St. Marys fr **Maggie Drazba** 2:24.39 800 / 5:17.86 1600 double, plus 2nd in 3200, to lead the Class A girls winners. Senior **Ashley Sigler** also doubled for the champs, with 33-00 SP / 106-10 DT
- **Williamstown** got wins in the 4x1, PV (**Matthew Looney**), runner-ups in both throws, and had lots of sprint and sprint relay depth for the Class A team victory
- Bishop Donahue sr **Lacey Hampton** 14.90 100H (nwi) / 46.65 300H / 5-03 HJ triple
- South Harrison jr **Gretchen Lantz** 1:00.36 400 / 16-06.75 LJ (nwi) double
- Richwood sr **Derrick Chaffin** doubled the 1600 (4:30.27) and 800 (1:59.76)
- Doddridge Co. sr **Zachary Holden** doubled the 110H (15.42, nwi) and 300H (41.33)
- **Charleston Catholic** boys won the 4x2, 4x4, and 4x8
- Wheeling jr **Aaron Schneid** doubled the SP (50-02) and DT (149-00)
